



Results of the third PHAEDRA workshop on ‘the EU Data Protection Regulation and regional perspectives on improving international cooperation between DPAs, PCs and PEAs’ – Report, October 2014

The third PHAEDRA workshop took place on 18 June 2014, during the 41st Asia Pacific Privacy Authorities (APPA) Forum, from 17-18 June 2014. The APPA Forum was attended by representatives from Data Protection Authorities (DPAs), Privacy Commissioners (PCs) and Privacy Enforcement Authorities (PEAs), and academia. The workshop was **opened by Hakyung Jeong**, chairman of the Personal Information Protection Commission of the Republic of Korea, and host of the APPA Forum. The workshop was chaired by Dr Mimi Miryung Kim (Vrije Universiteit Brussel) who also introduced the workshop.

The **first part of the workshop** was devoted to presentations by PHAEDRA consortium members. Gertjan Boulet (Vrije Universiteit Brussel) presented the PHAEDRA project.¹ Dr. Wojciech Rafał Wiewiórowski (GIODO) discussed the EU Data Protection Reform.

During the second part of the workshop, Mr. KWON Hyun-Joon (Korea Internet & Security Agency) presented a case regarding on-going Korea-China ISP cooperation.

Following points were raised during the discussion session of the second part of the workshop: privacy impact assessments and privacy by design; secrecy provisions; use and disclosure principles; civil wrongs.

During the third part of the workshop, Gertjan Boulet discussed the legal reports authored by Vrije Universiteit Brussel.²

During the fourth and last part of the workshop, Wojciech R. Wiewiórowski moderated an open discussion regarding barriers in international cooperation and coordination between DPAs, PCs, and PEAs as well as the ways to improve cooperation and coordination.

The workshop was **closed by Dr Mimi Miryung Kim**.
